The Amador Air Pollution Control District determines whether it is a permissible burn day depending on air quality. Even if it is a permissible burn day, NEVER burn if it is too windy. NEVER leave a fire unattended. NEVER start a fire without having all the appropriate equipment on hand: shovel, rake, water. NEVER burn in an unsafe location.
